Terwillegar Drive Expansion Stage 1 Construction Update April 2021

Terwillegar Drive Stage One: Whitemud Drive to Anthony Henday Drive

- → Widening Terwillegar Drive to four lanes in each direction (three for motor vehicles, one dedicated lane for transit)
- → Intersection upgrades
- → Upgraded bus stops with shelters
- → Shared-use path on the east side of Terwillegar Drive


Stage One North

- → South of Rabbit Hill Road to south of Whitemud Drive
- Intersections at Rabbit Hill Road and Bulyea Road / 40 Avenue
- → Shared-use path



Stage One South

- → South of Rabbit Hill Road to north of Anthony Henday Drive
- Intersections at Haddow Drive and 23 Avenue / Riverbend Road
- → Shared-use path



Construction timelines

Stage One - North

- → Earthwork: Complete
- → Road Construction: 2021 2022

Stage One - South

- → Earthwork: Summer 2021
- → Road Construction: 2022 2023

- → Shared-use path complete following road construction
- → Landscaping: road work is finalized in 2023

Construction plans

- Construction starts in the next few weeks
- Two lanes of traffic will remain open in each direction
- → Intersections will remain open expect for 2 to 4 nights of intersection paving
- → No traffic detours are required
- → Traffic speed during construction will be 50 km/h



Intersections

- → Dedicated turn lanes added
- → Intersection straightened at Bulyea / 40 Avenue
- → Access changes to the businesses south of 40 Avenue



Shared-use path

- → Removal of trees completed in March 2021
- Retaining walls for the shared-use path will be constructed at the same time as the roadway
- Connections at north end of path near Whitemud pedestrian bridge connection to be confirmed
