You are invited to apply for your ETS Senior Subsidy Annual Pass (valid January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024).

The cost for the 2024 Senior Annual Pass is based on your individual income. If your income is below \$32,319 reduced price options are available as listed below.

Tier	Individual Income Senior Annual Pass Price
1	Below \$29,380 = Free (requires proof of income)
2	Between \$29,381 and \$32,218 = \$139 annually (requires proof of income)

Tier 1 and 2 - income below \$32,218

- You are required to provide proof of income as well as proof of age.
- Please submit a copy of your proof of income along with the attached application form either **by mail**, **by emailing** a scanned copy, or photo, of your proof of income to etsseniorsspass@edmonton.ca
- To pay **in person**, please bring all required supporting documents along with your completed application to the Edmonton Service Center, located on the 2nd floor, Edmonton Tower, 10111 104 ave.
- You are required to provide proof of age by submitting a scanned copy or photo of a government ID with your name and date of birth.

Arc - The New Way to Pay for Transit

- Arc, the Edmonton region's new electronic fare payment system, is a convenient and flexible way to pay for transit.
- All senior fare riders, including monthly and annual pass holders, will transition to Arc between in 2024. ETS can assist you with this process.
- Starting in **spring 2024**, seniors who purchase ETS Senior Annual Passes will no longer receive an ETS paper or plastic pass. Seniors will be using an Arc card that you can load money onto.
- You will tap your Arc card on the fare validator when you get on the bus or LRT and you will tap your card again when you exit the bus or LRT.
- With Arc, you will no longer need to pay for your regular ETS Senior Annual Pass upfront. Instead you will pay for each trip as you take it, or pay-as-you-go.
- You'll be able to add as little as \$4 or as much as \$500 to your Arc account.
- **You will not pay more for transit service in Edmonton with Arc than what you pay for an ETS Senior Annual Pass.**
- Arc will give you the best fare possible with fare capping. Once you pay the equivalent of a daily, monthly or annual pass, you will get unlimited rides for the rest of the day, month or year for free.
- For example, in Edmonton, you pay \$2.75 for a 90-minute trip, including transfers. Once your trips reach the daily cap of \$10.25, you ride for free for the rest of the day (ETS-only). When your trips reach the cost of a monthly pass (\$35), you ride for free for the rest of the month across all participating transit agencies. When your trips reach the cost of an annual pass (\$139 or \$385), you ride for free on ETS only for the rest of the year.

Proof of Income:

A copy of any ONE of the following must be included to be eligible for Tier 1 or Tier 2:

- 2022 T4A (OAS) (if box 21, net supplement paid, shows any amount above zero).
- Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) letter of eligibility from the Government of Canada.
- 2022 Notice of Assessment (**line 15000**, gross individual income must be below \$32,319).
- Permanent Resident or a refugee document (to qualify, you must have been in Canada less than one year and have not filed a tax return).
- Proof of government Employment Insurance (EI) being received in the past three months.
- A copy of your Health Benefits Card within the last three months showing receipt of Income Support benefits.
- A copy of your Canada Pension Plan T4A(P) Form for the 2022 tax year showing credits for Disability Benefit.

Once your submission has been reviewed and payment has been received (if applicable), your annual pass will be mailed to you via Canada Post (to the address you submitted on this application).

Please note lost or stolen passes will not be replaced free of charge. Passes are non-transferable and **can only be used by the person they were purchased for.**
