It is the responsibility of the scrutineer to familiarize themselves with their duties under the *Local Authorities Election Act*, including sections 150, 152, 152.1 and 158, as failure to comply may be an offence punishable under the Act.

Scrutineer eligibility:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must not have been convicted within the last 10 years of an offence under the Local Authorities Election Act, the Election Finances and Contributions Disclosure Act or the Canada Election Act.
- Must present this form, signed by the candidate, to the Presiding Deputy and complete a Statement of Scrutineer at each voting station they attend.
- Identification may be required, and may be used to verify age eligibility.

Scrutineers may:

- Perform their duties at more than one voting station.
- Arrive at the voting station 30 minutes before the scheduled opening time or at any time during voting hours. Scrutineers who wish to observe the count at voting stations must arrive before the close of voting at 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
- Observe any person making a statement during voting hours from designated locations.
- Observe the opening of special ballot outer envelopes at the designated time(s) and location
- Object to a ballot during the counting of votes.
- Sign and take a photo of the ballot account.
- Have the candidate or an official agent of a candidate perform any of the duties of a scrutineer

Scrutineers may not:

- Be present at a voting station at the same time as a candidate or official agent.
- Vouch for another person.
- Object to the eligibility of a voter.
- Access or use the permanent electors register, including, without limitation, taking a photograph or making a copy of the register.
