

APARTMENT AND CONDO WASTE CONTAINER SHARING PROGRAM AGREEMENT FORM

**Waste
Services**



The Container Sharing Program allows adjacent multi-unit properties receiving communal collection to share containers to help address space concerns. It will help to reduce the number of containers needed per property, which can save space.

Properties sharing containers are eligible for extra garbage collection for a fee. This fee will be charged to the EPCOR account to which waste services are charged. The fee cannot be split between two accounts. The agreement and applicable form are no longer valid if one property exits the program. Containers will then be provided to each property.

PART 2 – CONDITIONS (ALL SITES MUST AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS) (PLEASE INITIAL):

The participating sites are adjacent to each other. For the purposes of this program, the term 'adjacent sites' refers to two or more sites that share a property line (i.e. are right next to each other) or are across the alley from one another. The proximity of sites on the Container Sharing Program is paramount and the final decision of whether or not two or more sites can share containers rests with the City of Edmonton.

The City shall not be responsible for wear and tear or any other type of damage caused to the property of owners as a result of providing waste collection services in a manner that is reasonably consistent with standard operating practices.

The sites sharing containers will be given containers based on the allocation for the total units of the sharing sites. If excess waste is generated, the City of Edmonton offers an excess waste program. This program aims to provide extra lifts up to 50% of the property's monthly garbage allocation for a fee. Sites need to register for the program by providing an EPCOR account number for the fee to be charged to.

The City of Edmonton will not mediate between the sites if illegal dumping occurs.

Waste Services is not responsible for removing garbage and other items around the containers to ensure the collection vehicle is able to access and service the containers on collection days.

Containers cannot be moved from the designated location except with the approval from City of Edmonton Waste Services.

All requirements of the Waste Services Bylaw 20363 must be adhered to.

Co-location of all three waste streams (food scraps, recycling and garbage) must be maintained.

The program will be offered at no additional expense to the sites and will not result in a reduction of the Utility Rate for the sharing sites.

City of Edmonton Waste Services retains authority to end this agreement for operational or safety concerns. This will result in containers for three streams to be provided to all the sites.
