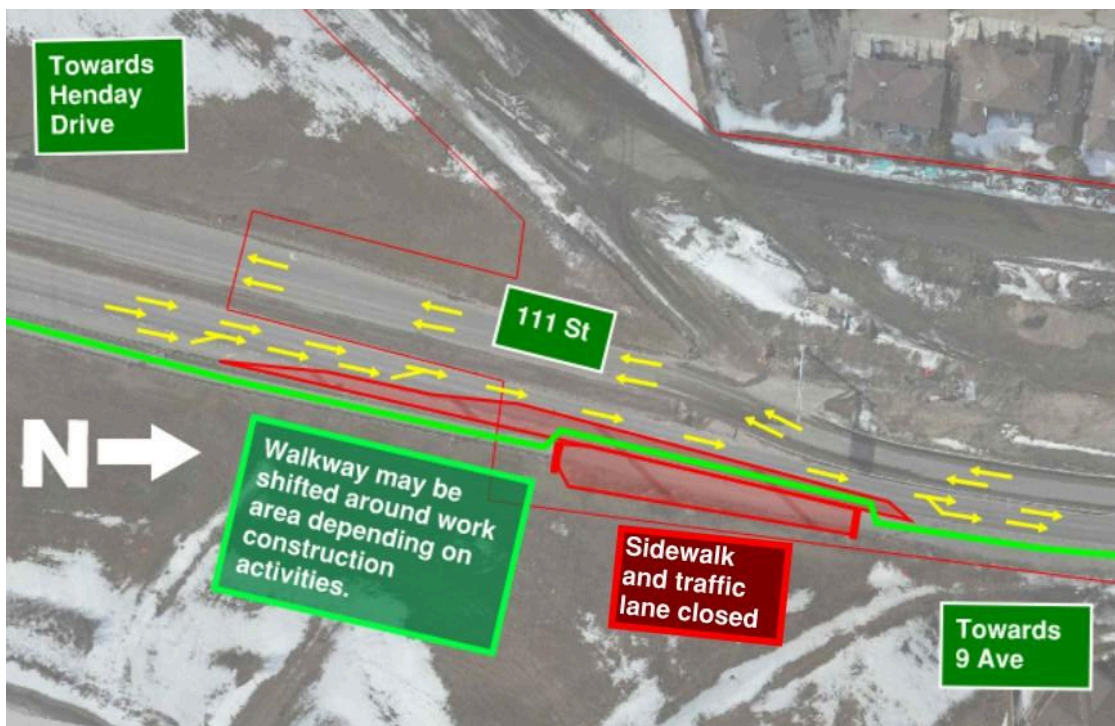


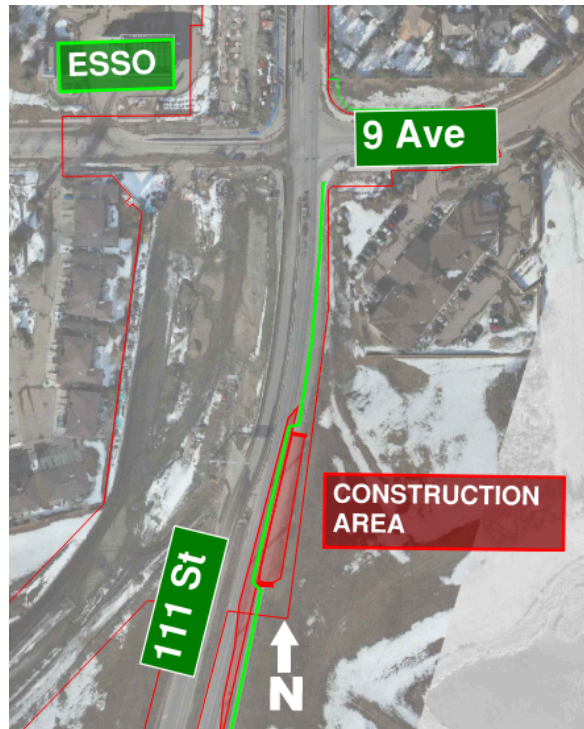
Construction Notice – Off-Peak Northbound Lane Closure on 111 Street near Anthony Henday Drive

Beginning **on/around May 11**, Leducor will temporarily close a section of one **northbound traffic lane on 111 Street between Anthony Henday Drive and 9 Avenue** to accommodate guardrail installation. This closure will occur intermittently on **weekdays during off-peak hours from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** This intermittent closure is expected to last approximately 5 days, and lanes will reopen at the end of every work shift. Traffic impacts

- Off-peak northbound lane closure on 111 Street near Anthony Henday Drive
- Appropriate construction signage and delineation devices will be installed along the temporary detour.
- Speed limits in the work zone will be reduced to 40 km/hr in each direction.

Other impacts

- Work will occur on weekdays between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- Pedestrian and cyclist routes will be maintained, and appropriate signage will be installed for the lane closures. Sidewalk access will be temporarily adjusted during work, and pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured into the closed traffic lane and communicated via signage. Temporary ramps will be utilized for safe mobility.
