## Terwillegar Drive Expansion: Stage 3

---

The City of Edmonton is partnering with the Province of Alberta to complete Terwillegar Drive Stage 3. This stage includes a new interchange and pedestrian/cyclist bridge over Anthony Henday Drive, along with corridor upgrades to support future traffic, transit and active transportation needs. **Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2026 (weather permitting).**

### Construction details

Construction on Stage 3 of the Terwillegar Drive Expansion Project will begin this spring and is expected to take approximately two years.

Stage 3 includes:

- A new bridge for northbound Terwillegar Drive over Anthony Henday Drive and repurposing the existing bridge for southbound traffic.
- Adding two loop ramps from southbound Terwillegar, one for eastbound Anthony Henday and one for northbound Terwillegar to westbound Anthony Henday.
- A new shared pathway/pedestrian bridge over Anthony Henday Drive, connecting Windermere Boulevard and Haddow Drive.
- Corridor upgrades, including the intersection at Windermere Boulevard.
- Widening of Terwillegar Drive and 170 Street from south of Haddow Drive to south of Windermere Boulevard to three southbound lanes, four northbound lanes and one dedicated transit lane in each direction.

### Access

- During construction, two lanes of traffic on Terwillegar Drive will be maintained in each direction.
- Short-term daytime and occasional nighttime lane closures may be required.
- Minor impacts to Anthony Henday Drive, including temporary lane closures and reduced speeds.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
- If you have special access requirements, such as DATS, please advise the contact person listed below as soon as possible.
