OLESKIW NEIGHBOURHOOD REHABILITATION

As part of the 2019 Neighbourhood Renewal Program, The City of Edmonton (Building Great Neighbourhoods) will be coordinating construction in the Oleskiw Neighbourhood.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to start the week of May 20, 2019 in your neighbourhood.

Prior to the start of construction in front of your house, the Prime Contractor working for the City will deliver a bulletin outlining the estimated start/finish dates along with their contact information.

Please note: the duration of construction in front of your house may be up to 5 weeks (weather dependent).

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction consists of road rehabilitation or road reconstruction. Rehabilitation involves either asphalt overlay, or full-depth reclamation (in-place road recycling) and asphalt overlay. Reconstruction involves the removal of existing asphalt and road base, placement of new road base, and asphalt paving.

On the back of this bulletin is a map of Oleskiw which identifies the work planned for 2019.

ACCESS

During construction, the areas affected by road rehabilitation will have one lane of traffic maintained in each direction. Areas affected by road reconstruction **will not** have vehicular access to the street or driveways. The construction will be staged to minimize disruptions to residents. No parking will be permitted in signed areas. Emergency access will be maintained at all times. ***If you have special access requirements, such as DATS, please contact the Project Manager to coordinate access.***

ROAD CLOSURES: Toward the completion of each portion of the project, the roadway will be closed to traffic on selected days to facilitate asphalt paving. A bulletin will be circulated to the affected homes and businesses 5 working days prior to this work.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

- If a garbage/recycle pickup date occurs during a street closure, please place bags at the end of the closure closest to your property.
- Please relocate sump hoses during construction to prevent drainage over the sidewalk.
